World Conservation Award

- Can be earned once as a Cub Scout
- Different Requirements for Each Rank
 - Listed in the Back of the Cub Scout Handbooks
 - Includes a Conservation Project

Outdoor Activity Award

- Can be earned at each Rank
 - First Time, the Scout receives the Pocket Flap
 - Successive Awards, the Scout receives a Wolf Track Pin

Special Outdoor Awards





Leave No Trace Awareness Award

- Can be earned once as a Cub Scout
- Requirements are the same for every Rank
 - Listed in the Back of the Cub Scout Handbooks
 - Includes Practicing Leave No Trace Guidelines on Three Outings

Paperwork



- Planning isn't complete without the Paperwork!
 - Permission Slip
 - A Permission Slip is Required for each Scout for Every Outing
 - It must be Signed buy the Scout's Parent or Guardian Prior to the Outing
 - Tour Permit
 - Must be Filed at the Council Office Prior to the Outing
